CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entrants must be amateurs and will be asked to produce a current CONGU handicap certificate.
2. Entry is restricted to the lowest 48 handicap entrants (handicaps at date of entry).
3. All unsuccessful entrants will be notified and their money refunded. **Entry fees are non-refundable once the draw has taken place.**
4. In the event of a tie the trophy and prize money will be shared, the same applies for other ties apart from the AM & PM prizes and handicap prize. No competitor will receive more than one prize.
5. Any caddies or trolley pullers must hold amateur status and are NOT permitted to go on to the putting greens.
6. A practice round may be played on Thursday 22nd July 2010 between 12 noon and 1.30pm. Please telephone 01923 854366 (Pro Shop) to book a time.
7. The EWGA Anti-Doping Rules apply to all competitors in this championship. Compliance is the responsibility of the competitor. The Anti-Doping Rules can be found on the EWGA website: www.englishwomensgolf.org
8. The event will be run under the rules of the R & A Rules Limited and the local rules of Porters Park Golf Club. In the event of any dispute the decision of the organising committee will be final.
9. For all play at Porters Park, a player may obtain distance information by using a device* that measures distance ONLY. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 of the Rules of Golf for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

*Within the Rules of Golf, another player may ask for information regarding distance from the player using the device.
